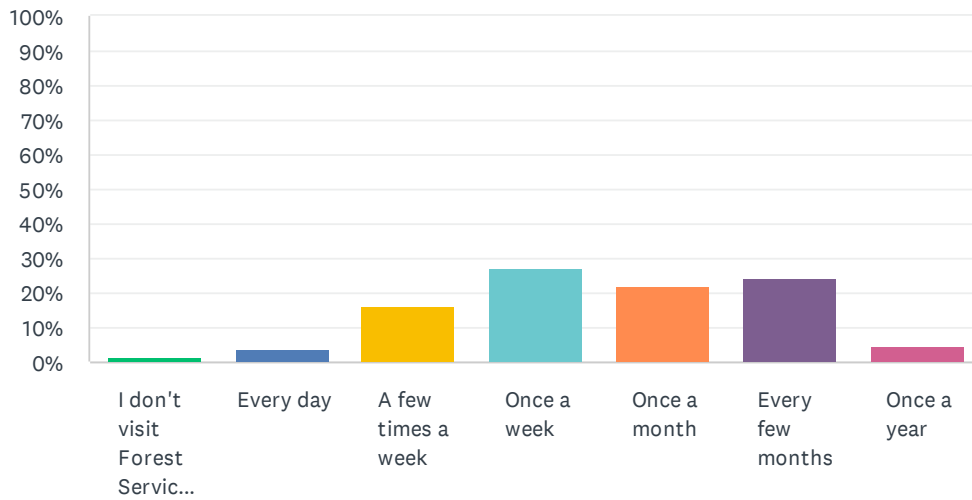


Q1 How often do you visit Forest Service Park?

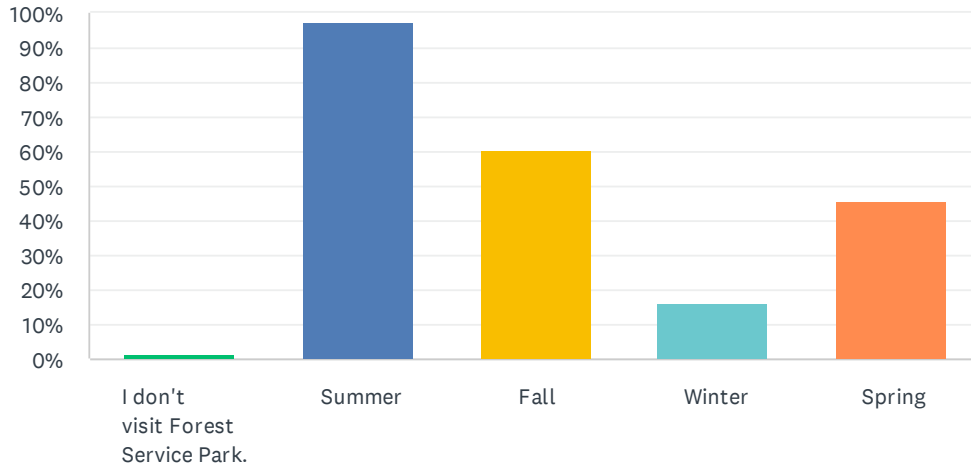

Q2 In which season do you visit Forest Service Park? (check all that apply)

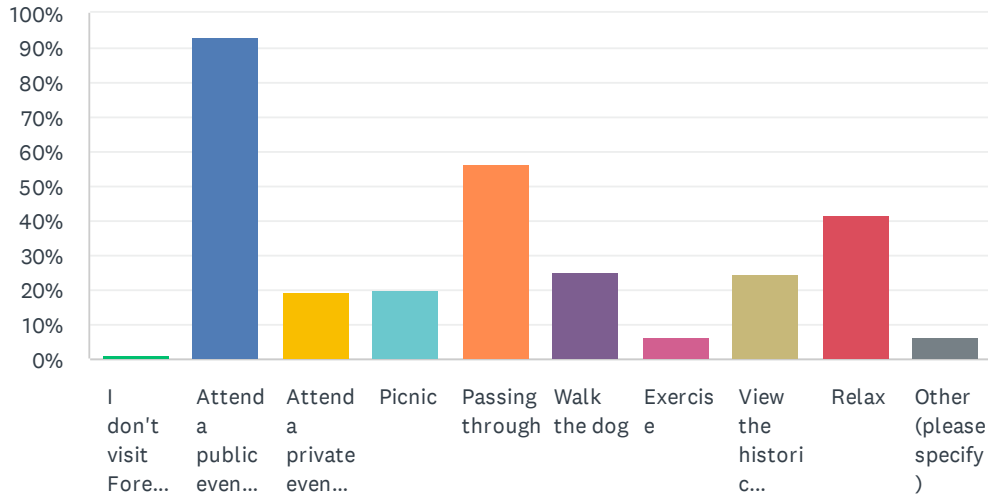

Q10 How likely are you to attend outdoor events at the park?

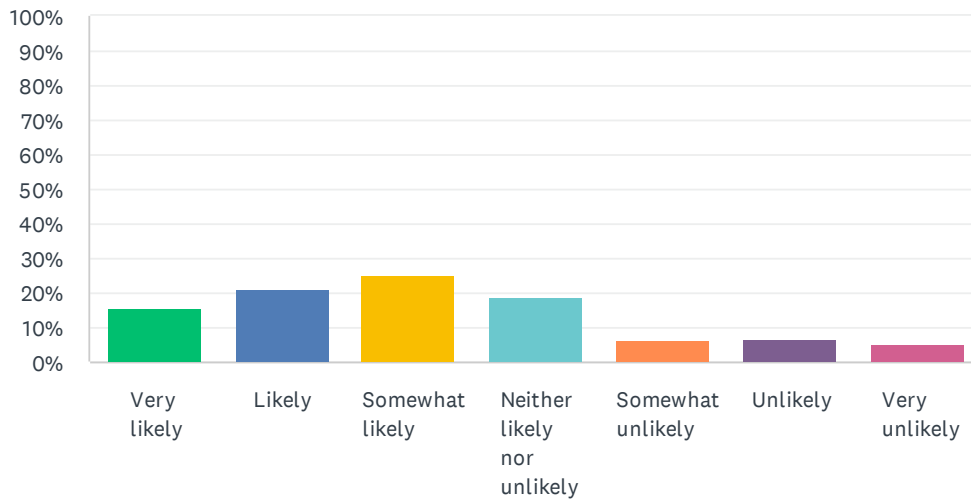
