

# GETTING AROUND WARM SPRINGS DURING WORLD CUP EVENTS



Special street closures, traffic control, and parking restrictions will occur in the 3-4 block radius around the Warm Springs Lodge (201 Picabo Street, Ketchum) during the 2025 World Cup events. These measures will ensure that emergency services and mass transportation (public shuttles/buses) can operate in the area without interruption and that residents can access their properties.

**Affected area:** Warm Springs Lodge and the 3-4 blocks around it

**Dates:** March 19-28, 2025

**Parking in the area:** available on private property only

- The public should park elsewhere and take busses or shuttles to the area.
- Additional parking lots throughout town will be activated as park-and-ride areas.
- Sun Valley Company's upper Warm Springs lot will be used for competition storage, infrastructure, and EMS services only. The lower lot will be restricted to competition parking and select permit holders only.

**Road closures; vehicle access for residents (owners and renters), authorized staff, event participants, and passholders only:**

- Picabo Street, between Ritchie Drive and Skiway Drive
- Gates Road, south of Picabo Street
- Puchner Lane, south of Picabo Street

**Shuttles and buses (free):** In addition to Mountain Rides' regular bus services ([mountainrides.org](http://mountainrides.org)), shuttles will be serving the area from March 19-27 that will provide transportation between the Warm Springs ski base area and the River Run ski base area or Sun Valley Village. Buses and shuttles will stop in front of the Greyhawk Alpine Center at Picabo Street and Ritchie Drive.

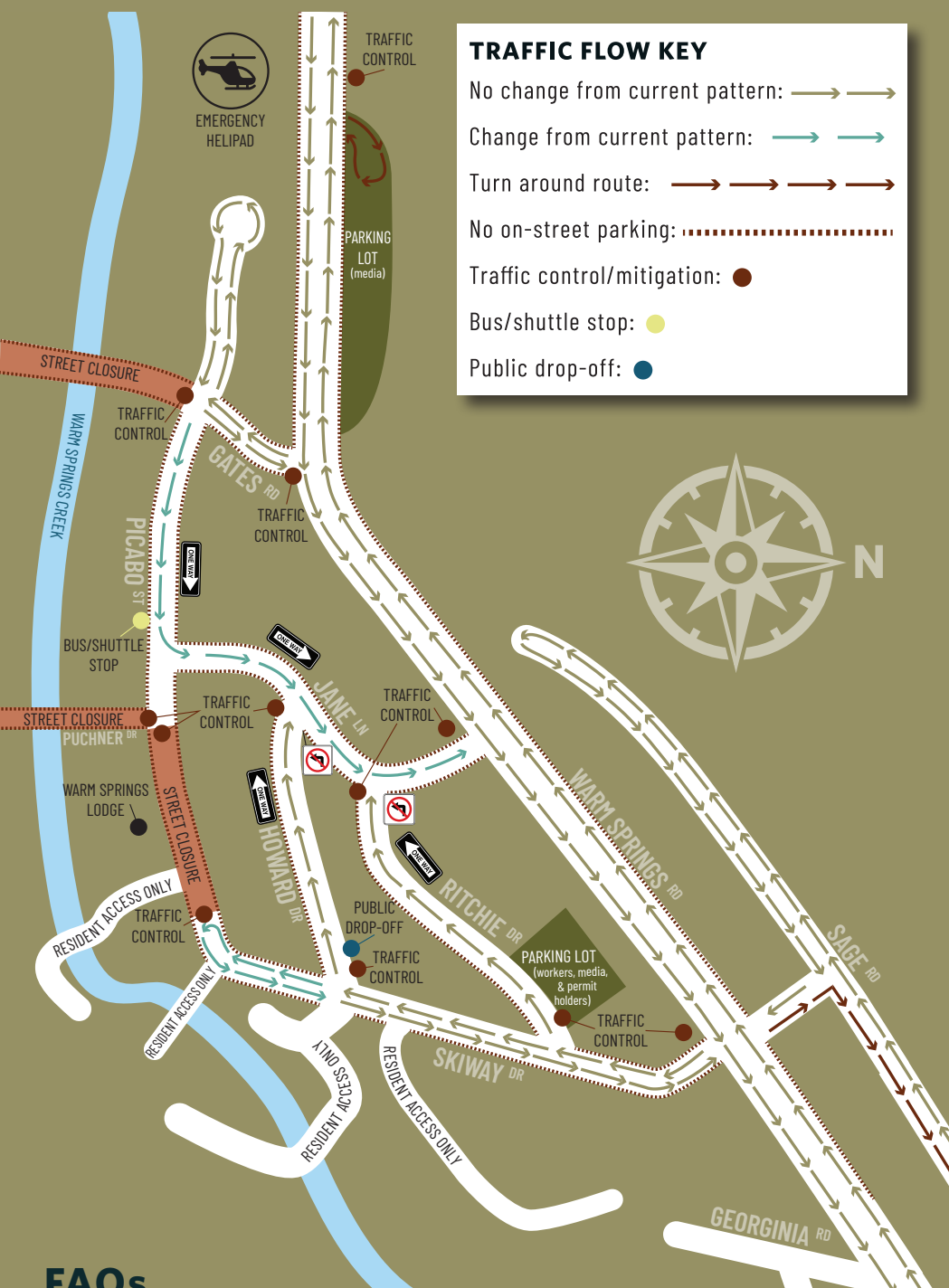
**Public drop off:** You may drop off passengers at a designated location a block away from the event area at Skiway Drive and Howard Drive. Those dropping off will be asked to leave the area immediately after dropping off to park their vehicle offsite.

**Traffic control/enforcement:** Signs and traffic control personnel will be positioned throughout the area to direct traffic and provide authorized access.

## FAQs

**Q:** Do I need a pass to access the area around Warm Springs Lodge?

**A:** No. But remember, there will be no public parking, except on private property. If you are not a full- or part-time resident at a property in the area, be prepared to take the bus/shuttle, walk, or drop off and park elsewhere.

**Q:** I work for a business or am contracted to do work for a property in the area. Can I park in the area during the World Cup events?

**A:** Only on private property. There will not be on-street parking available in the area.

**Q:** If our condo association limits the number of parking spaces residents are allotted during the events, where else can I park a vehicle?

**A:** On private property or designated on-street or public parking lot spaces outside the area. However, be sure to follow winter overnight parking rules that are in place in Ketchum City limits.
